U.S. citizens are invited to attend a meeting on Thursday, July 21, 2011 at 2:30 p.m. with the Regional Federal Benefits Office representatives from U.S. Consulate General Frankfurt and U.S. Embassy Warsaw. These representatives provide federal benefits services for beneficiaries who reside in Russia. The meeting will be held at the Consulate building, 15 Furshtatskaya St., St. Petersburg. The meeting is open to current beneficiaries and to any other U.S. citizens who have questions about federal benefit programs such as Social Security and Medicare.

The Regional Federal Benefits Office representatives will speak about issues relevant to Social Security beneficiaries/potential beneficiaries residing in Russia:

- available benefits
- payments outside the United States
- how to apply for a social security number

They will also be pleased to answer questions about:

- status of payments
- available methods of payments
- limitations of payments for beneficiaries who are not U.S. citizens and live in Russia
- Medicare

The representatives will be available for individual consultations following the general meeting.
